

RMH activities have been negatively affected because of disrespectful and disruptive behavior of some kids. This undisciplined behavior diminishes the enjoyment for other members. In addition, these actions give others a bad impression of RMH, its members, and homeschooling in general.

Field trips and events are a privilege, and the following protocol is to ensure all participants can enjoy and benefit from our activities. These guidelines are similar to ones found on the Internet from other groups.

- 1) Arrive at least 15 minutes beforehand. This ensures everyone has all the necessary instructions and is ready for respectful participation.
- 2) All persons in attendance must be polite, courteous, and attentive.
- 3) Do not be a no-show. If you are unable to attend an event for which you signed up, let the coordinator know as soon as possible.
- 4) If disrespectful or disruptive behavior happens and is not immediately discontinued, the following measures will occur:
 - A) The disruptive individuals will be required to leave the activity/event/field trip. Participation in future activities for these individuals will be welcome when they can exhibit polite, courteous, and attentive behavior.
 - B) If disruptive behavior happens at a second event, you will not be allowed to attend field trips and events for one month.
 - C) If disruptive behavior happens at a third event, you will not be allowed to attend field trips and events for the remainder of the school year.
- 5) If there is a fee, please pay when you register for the event or when specified by the coordinator. Participation in the event will not be allowed if the fee has not been paid.

Before attending any event each person, child and adult, must read, or have it read, this and acknowledge having read it. This ensures that everyone understands what is expected of them. To acknowledge, send an email to contact@RockyMountainHomeschool.org
